3. Venue

The venue is centrally located in Vienna's historic city centre, within walking distance of Stephansplatz, Stadtpark, and the Vienna State Opera.

On-site check-in will take place at the venue entrance. Please ensure you have completed online registration in advance.

4. Getting from Vienna International Airport (VIE) to the Venue

Vienna International Airport (VIE) is located approximately 18 km from the city centre. Typical travel time to the venue area is 20–30 minutes, depending on the mode of transport.

- **Option 1 – City Airport Train (CAT)**

Direct connection from the airport to Wien Mitte / Landstraße

Travel time: approx. 16 minutes

Ticket price: approx. €14.90 (one way)

From Wien Mitte: 15–20 minute walk via Stadtpark or approx. 5 minute taxi ride

- **Option 2 – S-Bahn (S7)**

Suburban train from the airport to Wien Mitte / Landstraße

Travel time: approx. 25–30 minutes

Ticket price: approx. €4.40 (one way)

Continue on foot or by taxi to the venue

- **Option 3 – Taxi / Ride-hailing**

Travel time: 20–30 minutes depending on traffic

Typical cost: €35–€45 per vehicle

5. Hotels in Walking Distance (3–4 Star)

The organising team cannot reserve room contingents. The following hotels are located within walking distance or short public transport distance of the venue. Participants are advised to book accommodation early.

Hotel Am Parkring (4★) – Am Heumarkt 35–37, 1030 Vienna – approx. 6 minute walk

Graben Hotel (4★) – Dorotheergasse 3, 1010 Vienna – approx. 8–10 minute walk

Hotel Royal (4★) – Singerstraße 3, 1010 Vienna – approx. 7–9 minute walk

Hotel Austria (3–4★) – Fleischmarkt 20, 1010 Vienna – approx. 10 minute walk

Hotel Am Konzerthaus – MGallery (4★) – Am Heumarkt 35–37, 1030 Vienna – approx. 12 minute walk

Austria Trend Hotel Savoyen Vienna (4★) – Rennweg 16, 1030 Vienna – approx. 10–15 minutes by tram or taxi

Mercure Grand Hotel Biedermeier Wien (4★) – Landstraßer Hauptstraße 28, 1030 Vienna – approx. 10 minutes by public transport
